This evening cohort-based program provides an academic and practical foundation in clinical psychology, counseling, and marriage and family therapy that prepares students to serve in community, government or educational settings, or within a private practice.

As part of the program, students gain supervised counseling experience in a clinical setting and are also equipped for doctoral programs in clinical psychology, counseling psychology, or family therapy.

Our evening, traditional classroom program covers 60 - 66 units over two to three years and is available at our West LA, Encino, and Irvine campuses. New students may begin the program during fall, spring, or summer session.


Individuals aspiring to work as counselors or licensed psychotherapists, or those preparing for doctoral programs are a great fit for Pepperdine's Master of Arts in Clinical Psychology program.

This cohort-based program offers the academic and practical foundation that prepares students to serve individuals, couples, families and groups, and fulfills California educational requirements for Licensed Marriage and Family Therapists (LMFT) and Licensed Professional Clinical Counselors (LPCC).

Coursework offers a strong foundation in clinical psychology, counseling, and marriage and family therapy, and can also equip students to go onto psychology doctoral programs.

As part of the program, students gain supervised counseling experience in clinical settings.

Our daytime, traditional classroom program covers 62 units over two academic years and is available at our scenic Malibu campus. New students begin the program each fall.



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
