Helpful Hints:

- **The provided "Year Plans" are to be utilized as a guideline, can be altered, and are not a required course map.**
- There are two required semesters of PSY 672/PSY 672A -or- PSY 673/PSY 673A Spanish Language & Culture course.
- The second Spanish Language & Culture course may be taken at the Irvine campus or in a Latin American country through the Immersion Program.
- There are three required semesters of practicum which are best taken in sequence and pre-practicum is required before beginning practicum. Students who are providing services in Spanish in the community need to enroll in the Bilingual Practicum course.
- Students may be required to take classes at different campuses in order to accommodate their desired schedule.
