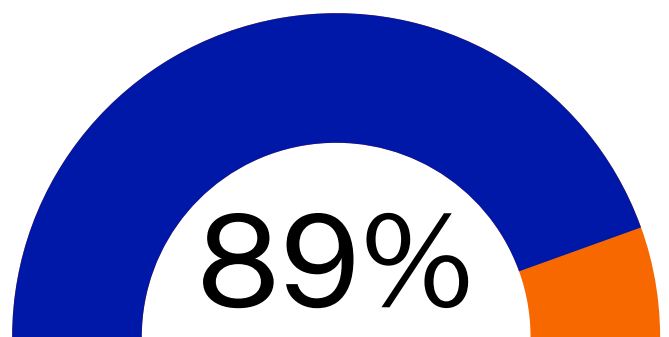

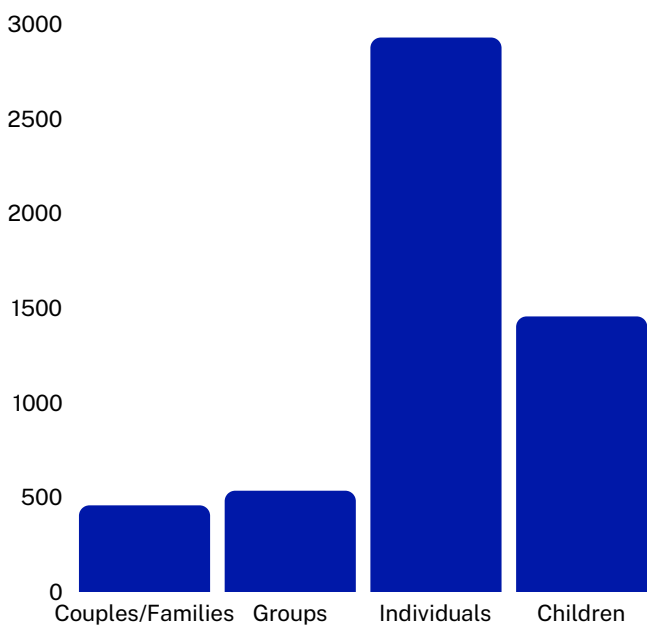

Services were provided across Los Angeles and Orange County through:

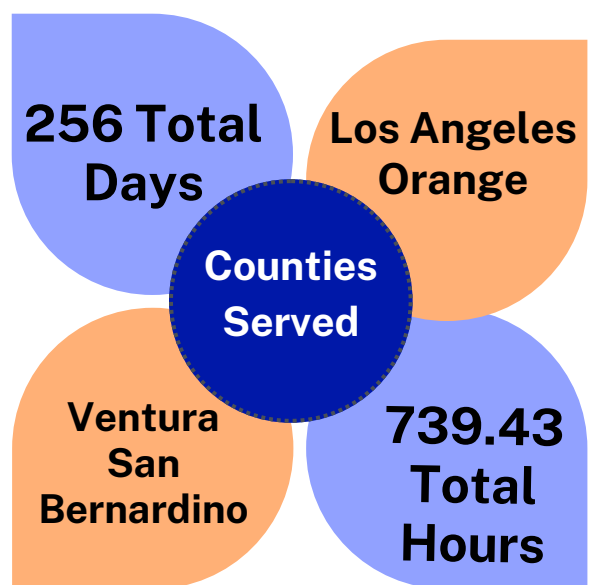
