

Give a Gift of Education Scholarship (GAGE) Application Form

This one-time scholarship of \$1,500 will be awarded to newly-admitted, full-time (6-units) students who have been selected by our GSEP Alumni Committee members. Continuing and part-time students are NOT eligible for this scholarship.

The GAGE Scholarship does not apply to students who are applying for the following programs:

- Master of Arts in Clinical Psychology with Emphasis in Marriage & Family Therapy (Daytime Format)
- Psy.D. in Clinical Psychology
- Ph.D. in Global Leadership and Change
- 100% Online Psychology programs

The deadlines for prospective and newly-admitted, full-time students to submit a GAGE scholarship application for the upcoming terms are: November 6 (Spring); March 5 (Summer I & II); and July 16 (Fall).
