

**CA STATE MFT STIPEND APPLICATIONS ARE NOW AVAILABLE!

WHAT IS THE STATE MFT STIPEND PROGRAM?

The California Department of Mental Health is awarding educational stipends to MFT students for the 2012-2013 academic year. The goal of the state's MFT stipend program is to increase its workforce with MFT interns who can provide services in underserved and hard-to-hire-communities.

DEADLINE TO APPLY:

October 15, 2012

ELIGIBILITY:

ONLY MFT students/alumni who have a graduation date between **July 1, 2012- June 30, 2013** qualify for these stipends. (NOTE: MAY IS YOUR CEREMONY DATE. YOUR GRADUATION DATE IS YOUR DEGREE POSTING DATE.) **Please consider the following criteria:**

- You must be willing to provide services for one year post-graduation in underserved communities or 'high need' areas.
- You must be willing to pursue licensure as an MFT. This stipend is not intended for those who plan on becoming licensed as psychologists (PhD or PsyD) in the future.
- Priority will be given to students with bilingual fluency and who have experience with underserved populations.
- Priority will be given to those who have had experience as a consumer or whose family members have been consumers of community mental health services.

HOW TO APPLY:

(Please follow these step-by-step instructions)

1. Carefully read the **Guide for 2012-2013 Application** found on <http://www.pgi.edu/page.php?id=350>
2. Decide **WHERE** you would like to serve in the state of California. Click on the application for that particular region. (Ex: If you would like to work in Irvine, select the Orange County Application. If you would like to work in Panorama City, select the Greater Los Angeles Application). **You may only select one area and submit only one application.**
3. After completing **Parts I and II** of application, **print out a copy of your unofficial transcript through Wavenet.**
4. Bring Parts I and II of application and unofficial transcript to an information session at a Pepperdine GSEP campus. Your application will be signed by Sadaf Mayet, Manager of Career Services and you will learn about what the selection committee is looking for in your essays. **APPLICATIONS WILL ONLY BE SIGNED DURING THE PRESENTATIONS.**
