Pepperdine's Master of Science in Behavioral Psychology is designed to prepare students to become highly competent in treating children and adults with autism spectrum disorders, and equipping them with the knowledge and experience necessary to work in this high-growth field.

In addition to rigorous theoretical study, the program incorporates three semesters of practicum and provides students with the opportunity to begin accruing the experience hours necessary for certification.

Our daytime, traditional classroom program covers 36 units over the course of 18 months to two years, and is available at our West LA campus. New students may begin the program during fall, spring, or summer session.


