Pepperdine's Master of Arts in Clinical Psychology with Latinas/os is the perfect match for those aiming to become a licensed psychotherapist or counselor in the underserved Latina/o communities.

This program provides an academic and practical foundation in clinical psychology, counseling, and marriage and family therapy that prepares students to serve in community, government and educational settings, or within a private practice.

As part of the program, students gain supervised counseling experience in a clinical setting and are also equipped for doctoral programs in clinical psychology, counseling, community psychology, or family therapy.

Our evening, traditional classroom program covers 66 - 72 units, including 24 to 30 units of Latina/o specific courses, over two to three years and is available at our Irvine, West LA, and Encino campuses. New students may begin the program each fall.


Application requirements:

- Interview with faculty
- \$200 deposit after acceptance
