Only applicants to the **2010 cohort of the Master of Arts in Social Entrepreneurship and Change degree program** at the Pepperdine University Graduate School of Education and Psychology are eligible to apply for this scholarship.

Candidates may apply for this scholarship concurrently with program admission. However, both a completed application for admission, including supplemental documents and completed scholarship application requirements must be received by July 15, 2010, for the applicant to be considered for scholarship.

A limited number of \$4500 scholarships are available. A complete list of instructions and requirements is stated below. To be eligible for scholarship consideration, it is the applicant's responsibility to comply with all requirements and instructions. Each scholarship application will be considered individually. Not all applicants will qualify. Admission to the program and application for scholarship do not constitute automatic scholarship award.

All scholarship applications must be received in the GSEP office of admissions by Thursday, July 15, 2010. Applicants will receive a confirmation of receipt via email, sent to the email address listed on this form.

Scholarship applications will be reviewed by committee. All scholarship applicants will receive notification of standing via email, on Monday, August 2, 2010.

- 1) Complete and submit application for admission with non-refundable \$55 processing fee
- 2) Submit all supporting documents required for application
- 3) Complete and submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- 4) Complete the data at the top of this form
- 5) Prepare a two-to-four page, typed essay, addressing the topic listed below
